

## Change of Name on a Liquor ID Policy

### Change of Name on a Liquor ID

Before updating his/her name with the [Registry of Motor Vehicles](#), a [customer](#) should notify the [Social Security Administration](#) of the name change. This will ensure that the customer's name in the Registry's database matches his/her name in the Social Security Administration's database.

*The Registry allows a customer to change names without having first notified the Social Security Administration only once, as a courtesy.*

Once the customer updates his/her name with the Registry, he/she will receive a new [driver's license](#), [learner's permit](#), or [ID card](#) with the updated information.

To conduct a change of name, the customer must submit the following at an [RMV Service Center](#):

- A completed [Class D, M, or D/M License and ID Card Application](#)
- The applicable fee. Refer to the [Driver's License, Learner's Permit, and ID Card Fees](#) section

At the [service center](#), an [RMV Service Center Manager](#) will capture a new signature from the customer.
